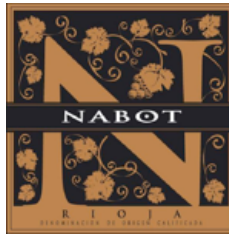


**2004 Santalba PLCB# 22946**



*Medium red. Meaty cherry and plum aromas are complemented by tobacco and musky herbs. Sweet dark fruit flavors are given a firm edge by tangy minerals and dusty tannins. Finishes with refreshing peppery bite and good persistence, repeating the cherry quality. I suspect that a few years of age will loosen this up. 88 POINTS Tanzer*

*Opaque ruby. Powerful, expansive dark berry, cherry, licorice and cola aromas are underscored by vanilla and smoky peat. Broad, lush and strikingly deep, offering luscious, liqueur-like blackberry and cassis flavors, with smoky oak spices and cherry-cola on the back end. Really stains the palate, reluctantly finishing with clinging spice and berry preserve flavors. What would this go with? A glass of port? Undeniably impressive but needs to be served by the ounce. 91 POINTS Tanzer*
